## PADDOCK INFORMATION

Staging Location: 500' west of the registration building. See map. Staging to start at 3pm Wednesday June 26th. Teams

traveling directly from Mid-Ohio to Road America may stage in this area starting on Monday, June 24th.

**Load In Begins:** PSSA: Wednesday, June 26 at 2:30 pm.

IGT/FRP: Wednesday, June 26 at 3:00 pm.

Trans Am: Wednesday, June 26th from 3:30 pm-6:00 pm (TA2 Class), Thursday, June 27th from 12:00 pm-

3:00pm (TA/GT Classes)

Load Out: Sunday, June 30th at 7 p.m. Trucks can be parked in the staging area until Monday morning, but all

vehicles must clear the paddock Sunday night.
